



THE PROCESS OF SALVATION

JUSTIFICATION	Immediate	Positional	"I am saved" FROM THE PENALTY OF SIN
SANCTIFICATION	Ongoing	Progressive	"I am being saved" FROM THE POWER OF SIN
GLORIFICATION	Ultimate	Realized	"I will be saved" FROM THE PRESENCE OF SIN

Romans 3:20 Therefore no one will be declared righteous in God's sight by the works of the law; rather, through the law we become conscious of our sin.

1ST - RIGHTEOUSNESS REVEALED

Romans 3:21 But now apart from the law the righteousness of God has been made known, to which the Law and the Prophets testify.

Galatians 3:24; Luke 24:44; Genesis 3:16, 21; Revelation 13:8

2ND - RIGHTEOUSNESS RECEIVED

How do we receive righteousness from God?

Romans 3:22a This righteousness is given through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe.

Who can receive it?

Romans 3:22b-23 There is no difference between Jew and Gentile, ²³for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

What do we receive?

- ❖ *Justification*
- ❖ *Redemption*
- ❖ *Propitiation*

Romans 3:24-25 and all are **justified** freely by his grace through the **redemption** that came by Christ Jesus. ²⁵ God presented Christ as a sacrifice of atonement, through the shedding of his blood—to be received by faith. He did this to demonstrate his righteousness, because **in his forbearance he had left the sins committed beforehand unpunished—**

Isaiah 53; Romans 5:8

3RD - RIGHTEOUSNESS REQUIRED

Romans 3:26 he did it **to demonstrate his righteousness** at the present time, so as **to be just** and the one who justifies those who have faith in Jesus.

Psalm 89:14 **Righteousness** and **justice** are the foundation of your throne; love and faithfulness go before you.
